Mrs. Chocron	<b>Crochet the Day Away</b> --Do you crochet? Want to learn? Want time to finish your projects? Come spend time with people who enjoy similar pursuits and hobbies. Please bring your own supplies.	Grades 6 – 8
Mrs. Stanton	<b>Science Olympiad</b> -- Students will begin exploring the various events they may be able to participate in while being a part of the Science Olympiad team. The Science Olympiad tournaments are rigorous, academic, interscholastic competitions that consist of a series of individual and team events which students prepare for during the year. Each year there are approximately 23 challenging and motivational events that are drawn from the various disciplines of biology, earth science, chemistry, physics, computers and technology. There is a balance between events requiring knowledge of science facts, concepts processes, skills and science applications.	Grades 6 – 8
Mrs. Eubanks	<b>Kahoot!</b> For this CAT class, we will be playing Kahoot, an online trivia game. Come test your knowledge in a variety of areas--sports, movies, music, history, geography. There will be a winner each week who receives a prize so the question is, "Do you have what it takes? Requirements ⇒ Must use your Acer laptop.
